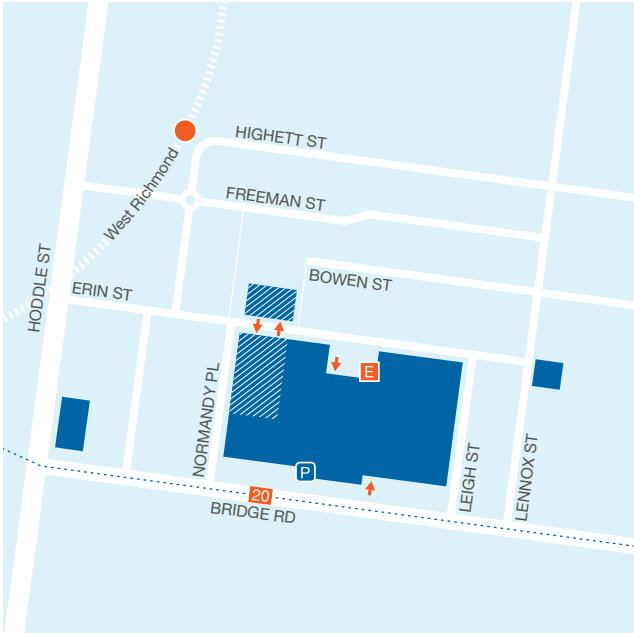

Speech Pathology Outpatient Service



Epworth Rehabilitation offers individually tailored outpatient Speech Pathology programs.

The programs offer treatment and management of a range of communication, cognitive and swallowing impairments.

Speech Pathology Team

The Speech Pathology Team at Epworth Rehabilitation comprises Speech Pathologists and an Allied Health Assistant.

Our Speech Pathologists are based at Richmond, Camberwell and Brighton.

All our staff are highly skilled and committed to providing quality patient care.

Speech Pathology at Epworth Rehabilitation

Speech Pathologists at Epworth Rehabilitation are responsible for the assessment, diagnosis, treatment and management of adults with a range of communication, cognitive and swallowing impairments.

These impairments may arise as a consequence of stroke, head injury, neuro-surgical intervention, progressive neurological disease, head or neck surgery or other general medical conditions.

Assessment and treatment of these conditions is tailored to the individual's needs. There is often a practical focus to assist the person to return to everyday life, including assistance with return to work or study. Staff involve family and friends where appropriate, providing education and support.

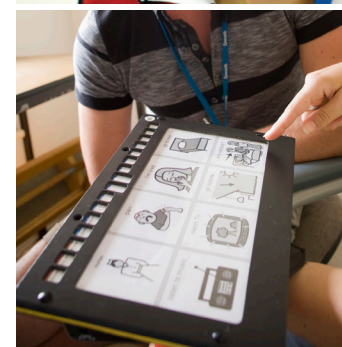
Outpatient programs

Speech Pathologists treating outpatients work in collaboration with other relevant Health Professionals, including Occupational Therapists, Physiotherapists, Medical Practitioners, Community Nurses, Psychologists and Dietitians.

Outpatient Speech Pathology services are available Monday to Friday (excluding public holidays) between 8.30am - 5.00pm, at our Richmond, Camberwell and Brighton facilities.

As well as treating outpatients with a range of communication and swallowing disorders we also offer the following:

- Assessment and management of Anosmic clients (disordered sense of smell and associated taste changes)
- Videofluoroscopy - swallowing x-ray. Available at Epworth Rehabilitation Richmond only.



Making an appointment

For Outpatient Speech Pathology services, an individual must be referred to a Rehabilitation Physician based at Epworth Rehabilitation. This will ensure that patients are managed within a team under the guidance of a Specialist, promoting quality service and continuity of care.

Referrals to the Videofluoroscopy Clinic are accepted directly from General Practitioners and all Medical Specialists.

It is recommended that individuals with Private Health Cover contact their insurer to clarify their level of entitlement.
