Grants are awarded to outstanding doctors to enable them to undertake research or training, or to gain exposure to new techniques and treatments to bring to patients at Epworth.




Innovation grants

The Marjorie Coombs Cancer Fund

Marjorie Coombs grew up on a livestock property at Merrijig Park, at the foot of Mount Buller in north-eastern Victoria, where her family bred Angus cattle and First Cross ewes.

“The farm and her animals were her life,” says Marjorie’s stock-and-station agent and friend, James Beckingsale. *“It was not uncommon to see Marjorie driving around in her Ute with five or six dogs in the back.”*

Marjorie was treated for cancer at Epworth Freemasons and, after she passed away in April 2007 at the age of 83, left a significant bequest to the Freemasons hospital in her Will, as a gesture of her great appreciation for the care she received.

Marjorie’s gift was used to establish the Marjorie Coombs Cancer Fund endowment, and every year, grants from the Marjorie Coombs Cancer Fund are distributed to support important cancer research including blood cancer, pancreatic cancer and prostate cancer.
