1. Patient screening leading up to fertility treatment

Presented by Dr Chris Russell, IVF specialist

Dr Russell will discuss the different patient screening requirements including bloods, ultrasound and semen analysis, what the results mean and the different aetiologies patients present with to fertility specialists. Dr Russell will then go on to discuss how screening and patient history can help determine which fertility treatment is most suitable for the patient.

2. Different fertility treatment options and advancements in IVF

Presented by Dr Sameer Jatkar, IVF specialist

Dr Jatkar will outline the different types of fertility treatment, including ovulation induction and timed intercourse, intrauterine insemination, and IVF. He will also discuss how technology-enabled IVF assists us in achieving success for patients and explain processes such as ICSI plus, timelapse imaging and vitrification.

3. Egg freezing

Presented by Dr Nicole Hope, IVF specialist

Dr Hope will discuss the process of egg freezing, what's involved, and why it may be a good option for patients who may want to conceive later in life.
