OVERVIEW

Our speakers will discuss a range of topics from fertility management and early pregnancy care. They will then go on to discuss the latest evidence in management of twins in early pregnancy, including which supplements to recommend, which genetic screening GPs can use and when, what extra tests are required, and what early 'red flags' to look out for in complicated twin pregnancies. This part of the presentation will be a GPs guide to the early management of twin pregnancies.
