| Procedure Name | Tier |
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| All craniotomies, craniectomies, and skull reconstructions inc microscopic surgeries, on brain, meninges, pituitary gland and cranial nerves. This includes cranial trauma, brain tumours and creebrovascular lesions, except as itemised elsewhere | Tier A |
| Anterior cervical spinal procedures including discectomy with or without fusion, corporectomy, and like procedures, with or without anterior plating | Tier A |
| Consulting | Tier A |
| Craniotomy under conditions of monitored sedation and local anaesthesia for brain mapping and/or resection of brain tumours and similar lesions | Tier A |
| Decompression of Chiari malformation or other pathology at cranio-cervical junction | Tier A |
| Insertion of subarachnoid or epidural catheter with reservoir pump for drug infusion or CSF withdrawal | Tier A |
| Laminectomies, laminotomies, discectomies, decompressive and reconstructive procedures of the spine and its contents, excluding instrumentation | Tier A |
| Lumbar puncture, cisternal puncture, ventricular tap, and subdural tap | Tier A |
| Muscle biopsy | Tier A |
| Nerve biopsy | Tier A |
| Nerve blocks | Tier A |
| Other percutaneous procedures at the foramen ovale for trigeminal neuralgia | Tier A |
| Peripheral nerve procedures, including decompressive procedures and reconstructive procedures on the peripheral nerves | Tier A |
| Posterior fossa-microvascular decompression procedures | Tier A |
| Radiofrequency lesioning of trigeminal nerve, cordotomy or other sites. | Tier A |
| Shunts: ventriculoperitoneal, ventriculoatrial, ventriculopleural, subdural peritoneal, and lumbar subarachnoid/peritoneal (or other cavity) | Tier A |
| Spinal cord surgery for decompression of spinal cord or spinal canal, for a variety of conditions, for intramedullary lesion, or intradural extramedullary lesion. | Tier A |
| Stereotactic surgery | Tier A |
| Surgery for tethered spinal cord, or for other congenital anomalies (eg diastematomyelia.) | Tier A |
| Anterior screw fixation of dens fracture | Tier B |

| Cirq robotic arm - assistance with pedicle screw placement in spinal surgery | Tier B |
| Cordotomy, rhizotomy, and dorsal column stimulators for the relief of pain | Tier B |
