Dental implant surgery - Preprosthetic surgery including advanced bone grafting, sinus lift and nerve lateralisation	Tier A
Dentoalveolar surgery - Surgical management of erupted and impacted teeth, management of facial and deep space infections, preprosthetic surgery, cysts, tumours, oral antral fistula repair and cryotherapy	Tier A
Head and neck tumours (benign) - Surgical management of benign pathology affecting the maxillofacial region, inclusive of pathology of the minor and major salivary glands	Tier A
Orthgognathic - Surgical correction of facial bone deformity and maloclussions, including access to the skull base, corrective jaw surgery for obstructive sleep apnoea	Tier A
Osseointegration - Craniofacial and intra-oral	Tier A
Trauma/infection - management of soft and hard tissue injuries and infections involving the entire facial skeleton and dentition	Tier A
Aesthetic facial surgery - Facial surgery eg rhinoplasty - excludes facelift, brow lift, blepharoplasty	Tier B
Cleft surgery - Secondary cleft lip and palate surgery eg bone grafting of maxilla - excludes primary cleft lip and palate surgery of <5yo	Tier B
Head and neck tumours (malignant) - Laser surgery	Tier B
Head and neck tumours (malignant) - Surgical management of malignant pathology affecting the maxillofacial region, inclusive of pathology of the minor and major salivary glands within a multidisciplinary team	Tier B
Major craniofacial surgery - Craniofacial surgery - including high level (Le Fort 2 and 3) midface osteotomies	Tier B
OsseoFrame - Customised Subperiosteal Jaw Frame Implantation	Tier B
Temporomandibular joint Surgery – arthrocentesis, arthroscopy and temporomandibular joint replacement	Tier B
Temporomandibular joint surgery - custom prosthesis	Tier B
Head and neck tumours (malignant) - TransOral Robotic Surgery (TORS)	Tier C
