Grant Availability

Grants are available up to the amount of \$20,000. A minimum of 2 grants will be awarded each funding round. Grants are awarded for use in the 2023 calendar year.

Eligibility Criteria

Any individual or group within Epworth can apply for a Guest Speaker Grant.

Each application will require a Project Lead, who will be responsible for submitting the application, and will be the key contact for relevant communications and submission of reporting requirements.

Epworth employees or accredited VMOs are eligible to be a Project Lead and must meet the following criteria:

Application Process

Each application must have a nominated Project Lead. The Project Lead will be responsible for all communications regarding the grant as well as the grant compliance requirements. The application form will allow for the details for additional Project Members to be listed.

The Project Lead will be asked to represent the group in the selection process:







Selection Panel

The selection panel, responsible for the shortlisting and interview process, will comprise of the following members -

- Executive Director Epworth Medical Foundation and Brand
- Chief Operating Officer, Hospitals (or delegate)
- Executive Director People and Culture

Application Requirements

Project Lead will must complete and submit the application form. The application form will require:

- Detail on proposed guest expert (including CV)
- Overview of planned topic
- Anticipated audience
- Benefit to Epworth
- Budget
