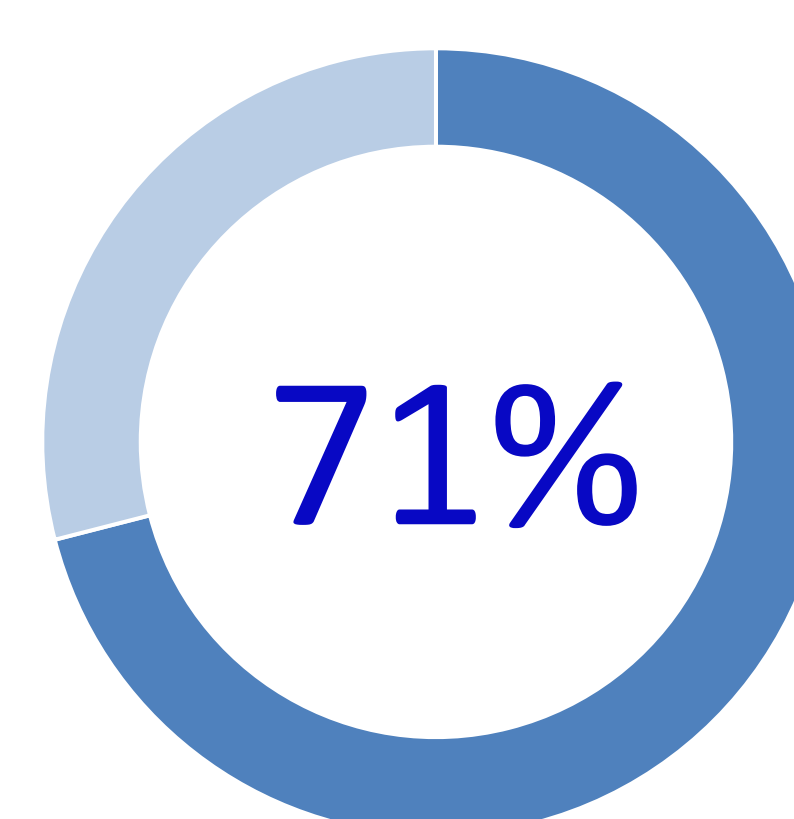
## Research active hospitals have better outcomes\*

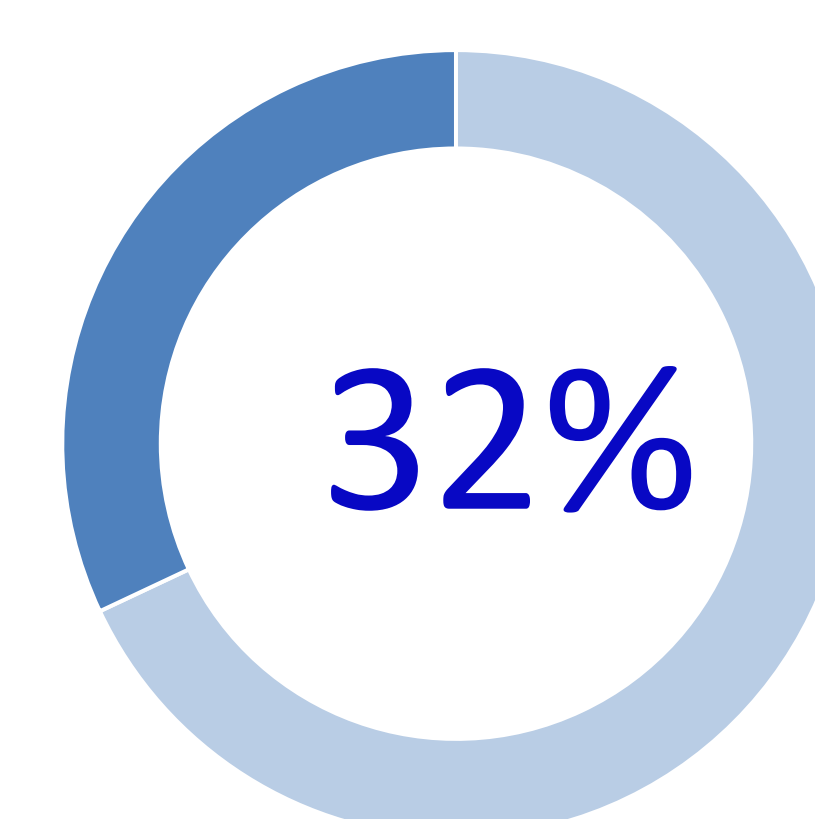

49% unaware of research mentors

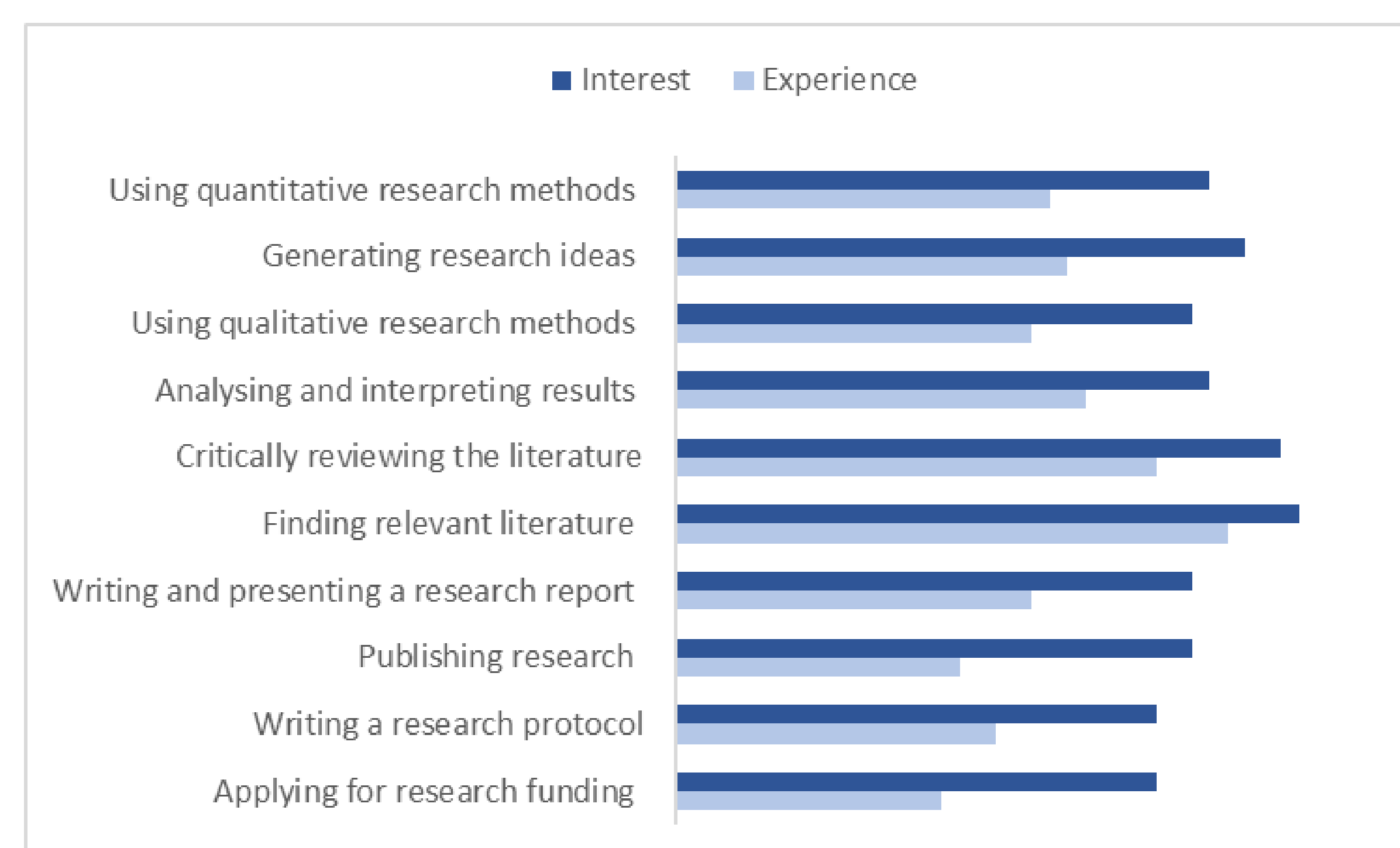


72% unaware of A & M resources
