Aerosol generating procedures (AGPs)

Patients with SUSPECTED or CONFIRMED COVID-19

- > N95 mask
- > Eye protection* / Face shield
- > Long-sleeved gown
- > Gloves (non sterile)

Standard precautions

Standard precautions plus the following for staff and VMOs with direct patient contact:

- > Hand hygiene
- > Gloves
- > Surgical mask

Staff performing an AGP on a person identified as low or no risk of COVID-19 **may choose to wear** the following as part of standard precautions:

- > Eye protection*
- > Long-sleeved gown / apron

* Note: Prescription glasses are not sufficient eye protection - face shield must be worn over top.
